Secure events and building sites

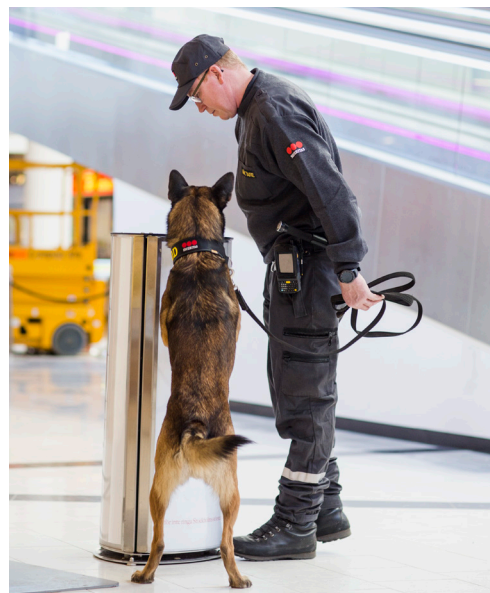

entrance to the event by acting as a complement to manual searches. At mines and building sites where blasting occurs, EDD teams can instead be used to secure the site and work environment by detecting any undetonated explosive charges in the area, thereby helping you to more efficiently prevent workplace accidents.
